

## Acceptable Use Notice

This Acceptable Usage Notice sets out the terms between you (the user) and us (British Wheelchair Basketball) under which you may use any domain, application or website (the site) owned by British Wheelchair Basketball to communicate and share information with others.

### 1. Content standards

All content must adhere to the spirit and the letter of the following standard. The standards apply to each part of any contribution as well as to its whole:

Contributions must:

- Be accurate (where they state facts).
- Be genuinely held (where they state opinions).
- Comply with applicable law in the UK and in any country from which they are posted.
- Not contain nudity or sexually explicit material.
- Not include or encourage violent or threatening behaviour including bullying or harassment of other users or third parties.
- Not include discriminatory images or text including but not limited to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex, gender, sexual orientation, disability, age or medical condition.
- Only contain information for which you own the copyright or have the express permission of the copyright holder for all content including but not limited to text and images (including video and animations). Any content found to be in breach of this will be removed.
- Not contain images or personal information belonging to third parties without having obtained permission from the third party in advance and in line with UK data protection law.
- Not contain libellous or potentially libellous or defamatory statements.
- Not contain content which seeks to undermine British Wheelchair Basketball or is in direct opposition to the rules, regulations and policies of British Wheelchair Basketball.
- Not give the impression that opinions and views emanate from British Wheelchair Basketball, if this is not the case.
- Not contain malicious items including but not limited to viruses, Trojan horses, worms, time-bombs, keystroke loggers, spyware, adware or any other harmful programs or similar computer code designed to adversely affect the operation of any computer software or hardware.

### 2. Violations

Violations of this notice may result in;

- Immediate, temporary or permanent suspension of your access to your account.
- Immediate, temporary or permanent removal of any content created by you.
- The issuing of a warning to you
