

Classification Points in British Wheelchair Basketball Leagues 2024-2025

Cap on team points on court

The number of classification team points allowed on court will be capped in all divisions. This is the maximum points allowable for the 5 players on court at any time including concessions. The maximum points allowed in each division are shown below:

League	Normal Points	Maximum Points
Premier Division	14.5	17
1st Division	14.5	17
2nd Division	14.5	17
3rd Division	15.0	17.5
Women's Premier Division	14.5	14.5
Junior League	16	17.5
Women's League Division 1	15.5	16.5
Women's League all other divisions	16	18

Explanation:

In line with the current maximum points on court per division, this allows teams to increase their points by a maximum of up to 2.5 points by playing women or juniors. Once this total has been reached, any additional woman or junior player put on court must play to their normal classification and the team will not receive any additional concession to increase the team points.

Additions Permitted on court for the following players:

TRANS ATHLETE REGULATIONS (Rule & Regulations pp15)

1.6.17 Trans men and trans women are eligible to compete in any male or non-gender specific competition. The team classification total would not increase when the athlete enters the court.

1.6.18 Non-binary athletes whose sex at birth is female are eligible to compete in female specific competitions.

1.6.19 Non-binary athletes whose sex at birth is female are eligible to compete in nongendered competitions. The team classification total would increase in line with the regulations for female and junior players specific to that competition.

1.6.20 Non-binary athletes whose sex at birth is male are eligible to compete in male specific competitions.

1.6.21 Non-binary athletes whose sex at birth is male are eligible to compete in nongendered competitions. The team classification total would not increase when the athlete enters the court.
